Librarian & Teacher Game Plan for the Family Readathon

- Spread the word about the Readathon to students and families.
- Encourage students to click on their school link and register so that they will be eligible for prizes – parents, librarians and teachers can help.

- Download the 2-sided [reading diary](#), share and review instructions with students.
- Messages of support from BookSpring will be sent to students throughout the Readathon. **Make sure students do not use their school emails.**

- During or at the end of the Readathon reading period, students record minutes read in their online **reading report** – parents, librarians and teachers can help.
