Librarian & Teacher Game Plan for Student Readers

- Click on your school link for complete details for Family Readathon Reading Schools
- Spread the word about the Readathon to students and families.
- Encourage students to click on their school link and start logging minutes read online on January 22 and as many times as they wish during the 20-day reading period.
- All readers who log their minutes are eligible for prizes – parents, librarians and teachers can help.
- Download the 2-sided [reading diary](#) and encourage students to set reading goals.
- Messages of support from BookSpring will be sent to students throughout the Readathon. **Make sure students do not use their school emails.**
- All participating librarians, teachers and registered kids get a free t-shirt. Curbside pickup at BookSpring is available to schools and families through February.
- During or at the end of the Readathon reading period, students record minutes read in their online **reading report** – parents, librarians and teachers can help.
